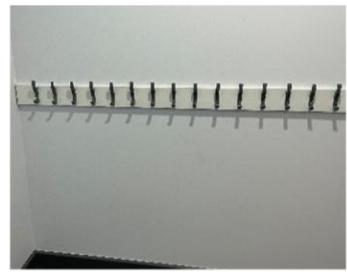

Coming to school ...

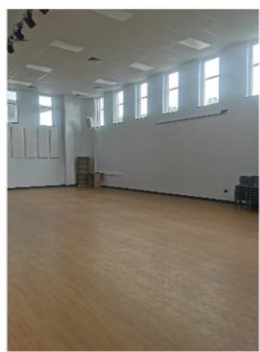
When you come to school you will come through the 'Early Years Entrance' gate and go into your classroom.

If there is anything out in the outdoor area – try not to touch or play with it as this has been set up for some fun learning during the day.



You will need to take off your coat and hang it on your peg in the cloakroom. You will need to make sure your book bags and PE kit are away in the big grey drawers.

These are the toilets we will use – they are inside our classroom. Remember to flush the toilet after you've been and then always wash your hands. Please make sure you put your used paper towels in the bin.



This is the hall. We will use it every day at lunchtime where we will sit on tables with friends from our House teams. We will also go to the hall for assemblies with Mrs Thompson (our Head of School), these assemblies will probably include her reading a story (she loves reading!).

To get to the hall we need to walk up some stairs, we will do this safely by holding on to the handrail and walking one behind the other all sticking to one side of the stairs.
