People in our Community visit - Castlefield Viaduct

This week we were lucky to welcome a lovely visitor Beth from the National Trust to talk to us all about Castlefield Viaduct sky garden. Beth spent time with both Pre-School and Reception and talked to the children about what the viaduct was in the past, what it is now and how long it has been a garden for. We then talked about what gardeners do and what you'll find in the garden - including both plants and animals. We loved looking at the animal puppets and talking about the different animals that visit the viaduct. The children listened incredibly well, showed great respect and asked lots of engaging questions throughout the visit and developed their sense of community and

citizenship. Thank you to Miss Mcleod Marsh who organised the visit for us.
