All things Attendance (reminders, rules and policy)

Full attendance at school is critical for both your child's academic success, but also their personal and social development too.

To support us with this we ask that parent/carers:

- promote the importance of good attendance and punctuality
- ensure their child arrives at school on time each day gate opens at 8.45am
- notify the school **each day** their child is unable to attend and provide a reason (due to child being unwell/illness)
- arrange medical appointments, where possible, for out of school hours and provide evidence for all medical appointments
- pay attention to the school's '<u>Term Dates</u>' and avoid taking their child/children on holiday in term time

Since summer, updated Government guidance came into force regarding fines for term time absences. Fines are typically issued by the Local Authority if a child has an unauthorised absence for 5 days or more. The first time a family incurs a fine it could be up to £160 per parent per child, a second will be at least this figure and any further instances within a three-year period could result in a criminal conviction.

There are exceptional circumstances in which short term time absences can be authorised but even these should of course be kept to a minimum. Should you need to request an absence, this must be submitted in writing through our School Office to admin@crownstreetprimary.org.uk
