<p>The world around us</p> <p>Spring time is a time of celebrating new life. Go on a Spring welly walk. What new life can you spot?</p> 	<p>Listening Game</p> <p>Can you play I – Spy? Have a go at using the digraphs we have been learning in phonics.</p> 	<p>Maths Challenge</p> <p>Draw a number line up to 10 – this could be on the floor outside using chalk or you could make it with paper. If an adult says a number can you identify one more than that number? Can you identify one less than that number? If you hide a number can you spot which one is hidden?</p> 
<p>World Book Day</p> <p>Can you design and colour a bookmark for your favourite book? See if you can include any characters or settings from the book.</p> 	<p>Reading Challenge</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read a book in your pyjamas • Read a funny story • Read a book about animals. • Read a rhyming book • Read outdoors • Read to your teddy • Read a non-fiction book • Read a book wearing a silly hat! 	<p>Children’s Mental Health Week</p> <p>What do you like to do to relax?</p>  <p>Post a photograph to tapestry showing us how you like to relax and we can talk about it during circle time, and maybe try it ourselves.</p>
<p>Observational Drawing</p>  <p><u>How to Draw Spring Flowers</u></p> <p>Draw some Spring flowers, you can use this video to help or find some outside.</p> <p>What shapes can you see? Do you know the name of these Spring flowers? Can you label your picture?</p>	<p>Art Challenge</p> <p>This term, we will be learning about the artist Gustav Klimt. Can you create some artwork inspired by his paintings of nature? Maybe you could do your own ‘Tree of Life’.</p> 	<p>Food Tasting</p> <p>Can you try a food you have never tasted before? Upload a picture to tapestry and tell us what it smelt, tasted like and if you enjoyed it.</p>
